“Hope has two beautiful daughters. Their names are Anger and Courage. Anger at the way things are and Courage to see that they do not remain as they are.” So wrote St Augustine 1,500 years ago.

Pope Francis has come and gone. The media made the visit available to millions in Ireland and around the world.

Some wanted to greet and support him, others looked for hope and guidance, many others for healing or redress. As in the Gospel story of the healing of the man with the withered hand, some watched for a chance to use something against him.

Fr Pat’s organisation and guidance and the community spirit among our pilgrims made the parish pilgrimage to the Phoenix Park an experience of faith. There was a sense of belonging greater than ourselves.

The papal visit was almost overwhelmed by the failure of church people, among others in Ireland, to protect vulnerable children and adults. His prayers for forgiveness, and his tenderness and humility in meetings with families and poor and the homeless people revealed faith, hope and love.

For a few moments with the Irish bishops before he left, Pope Francis spoke of *“the Church’s need to acknowledge and remedy, with evangelical honesty and courage, past failures – grave sins – with regard to the protection of children and vulnerable adults”*.

He asked them, *“to encourage and inspire, to reconcile and unify, and to preserve all the good handed down from generation to generation in this great family which is the Church in Ireland”*. He asked them to support our priests, whose hurt and discouragement in

the face of recent scandals are often ignored or underestimated.

All the while we have to face our daily life with Hope and Courage. Pope Francis suggested that we pray the oldest prayer in the church to Mary. (older than the Hail Mary)

We fly to your help

O Holy Mother of God.

Do not despise

our prayers

and our needs

but graciously hear

and answer them

Amen The ‘Sub Tuum prayer...’

He told the bishops, *“I am close to you: keep moving ahead with courage! The Lord is very good, and Our Lady is watching over you. When things get a little difficult, pray the Sub tuum...”* If this is how the pope and bishops pray when it gets a little difficult, so might we.
