We share your dream for an outgoing Church, open to all, especially the weakest, a field hospital Church.

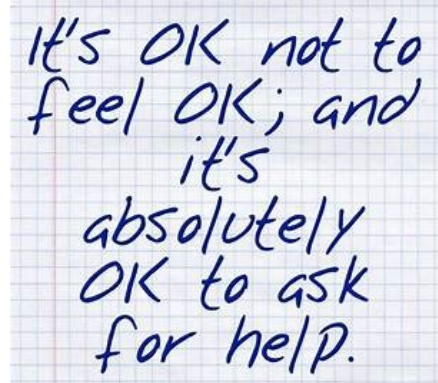
