Sunday 13 January 2019

Last Thursday on Bishop's Street, in the city, a man with two small children was trying to reverse into a parking space.

The available space was blocked by a wheelie bin. The traffic came to a stop. One driver in the queue began to lean on the horn. That didn't help anyone.

A young fellow whizzed up on his bike, on the inside. He could have cycled around the obstruction and sped on his way. But, he saw what was going on. He got off and in ten seconds, moved the bin out of the way. He jumped back on his bike and was gone. The traffic flowed on again. It doesn't happen every day.

What if it was the norm?

In today's gospel we have the story of the Baptism of Jesus in the Jordan and heaven opening and God saying,
"This is my beloved son. I am well pleased with him".
