Palm Sunday 14 April 2019

On the 4th of December, 1875, the “Deutschland” was wrecked on a sandbank off the English coast, killing 78 people, including 5 Franciscan nuns escaping persecution in Germany. The poet and priest, Gerald Manley Hopkins wrote a poem inspired by the tragedy.

At the end of the poem he asks one of the nuns, now in heaven, to pray for us.

“Let him Easter in us, be a daystar to the dimness in us, be a crimson cresseted East”.

A cresset is a steel basket or brazier holding red coals of fire, like the dawn light in the eastern sky. Hopkins sees that Easter is not just a past event, but what Jesus is doing in us now. Like the dawning day, he prays for Christ to flood our lives with his light, to easter in us, to give us hope, every day.

Dawn Mass :On Easter Sunday we will have Mass at dawn in St Mary’s Cemetery. As the sun rises, so our hope.

When someone is dying, family and friends try to be with the beloved, during the final hours. They stay together during and after the funeral, sharing memories and supporting one another.

Holy Week is such a time for the family of the parish, the friends of Jesus; to pray and be together as a community. We pray in hope, that he will Easter in us; comfort our grief, encourage us in loss or failure, support us in misunderstanding, forgive mistakes, relieve our fears and anxieties, soften our edges and selfishness, make us generous and kind, and strengthen us to try better. Our darkest corners can come safely and hopefully into the light.


Let him Easter in us
