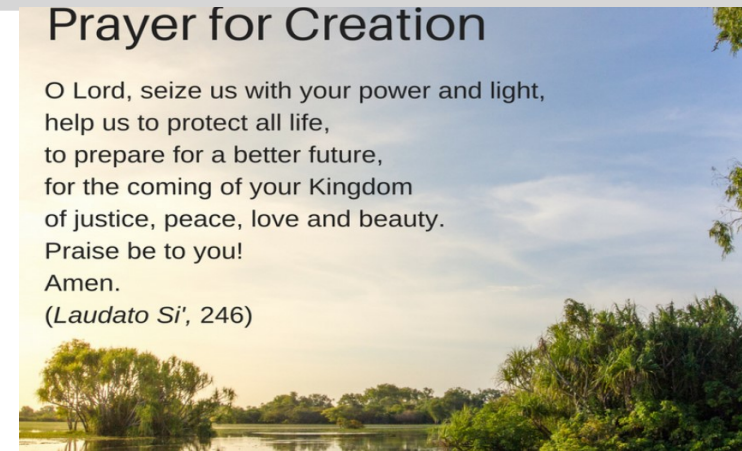

## Pope Francis' Message for Prayer for Care of Creation

*From the Vatican, 1 Sept 2019*  
The Season of Creation began on Sunday, 1 September, World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation, and ends on Friday, 4 October, the feast of Saint Francis. It is a season of increased prayer and effort on behalf of our common home.

"And God saw that it was good" (Gen 1:25).

God's looks lovingly on his creation, which he offers to men and women as a precious gift to be preserved.

Tragically we have caused a climate emergency that threatens nature and life itself, including our own.

In effect, we have forgotten who we are: creatures made in the image of God (cf. Gen 1:27) and called to dwell as brothers and sisters in a common home.

For this reason, I strongly encourage the faithful to pray during this season of prayer for creation. In this ecological crisis affecting everyone, we feel close to all people of good will who feel called to promote stewardship of the network of life of which we are part.

Saint Bonaventure said that creation is the first "book" that God opens before our eyes. In this book, every creature is "a word of God".

Hope for tomorrow is not just a noble sentiment but calls for concrete actions here and now. We owe our young people real answers, not empty words.

## The courage to do good, not waiting for someone else to begin

The season of prayer for creation is for us to reflect on our lifestyles; how our daily decisions about food, water, transport, energy and material goods, can be thoughtless and harmful. Let us try to adopt simple and respectful lifestyles!

Young people remind us that the earth is not a possession to be squandered, but an inheritance to be handed down.

Moses said to the people: "Choose life, that you and your descendants may live. Duet3:19 Let us choose life!

Let us say "no" to consumerist greed, for these are the ways of death. Let us make responsible sacrifices today for the sake of life tomorrow.

Every one of us is a thin yet unique and indispensable thread in the network of life.

May God, "the lover of life", grant us the courage to do good without waiting for someone else to begin, or until it is too late. FRANCIS
